# The traveler's source for Highway & Travel Information

With a rapidly growing transportation system, travelers need current travel information fast.

By dialing **511**, motorists throughout Arizona can get current road conditions in order to plan their trips. **511** now uses voice activated technology.

**511** delivers information directly to travelers as they are choosing their daily travel options.

Get current reports about:

- Road conditions and detours
- Transit
- Major airports
- Tourism
- Metro region Quick Reports

Information is updated every five minutes to provide you with the most current travel conditions.

The **511** system provides a direct link to the Valley Metro services in Phoenix, Sun Trans bus service in Tucson; as well as various rural transit providers.

You can also obtain traffic-related information about Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport, Tucson International Airport as well as the Grand Canyon National Park.

# How to use Arizona 511 service

Dial **511** and follow the automatic voice activated prompts for current road conditions, including detours due to traffic accidents or construction. You may also access local transit and airport information.

You can dial **511** from any cell or conventional phone 24 hours a day.

When you use the **511** system, you will need to listen to the entire automated introduction. Since the system is activated by voice, reduce as much background noise as possible.

**Quick Reports** – provide detailed travel information for specific locations.

Metropolitan Phoenix is divided into six zones as referenced on the map below.

Information is also available about Tucson under Quick Reports.

**Touch Tone Reports** – from any menu, press the star key (\*) which allows the user to switch between speech-recognition and touch-tone modes.

We hope as you familiarize yourself with this valuable service, **511** will help you plan ahead for your travel.
